A new statutory university named as "Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, Punjab" has been established by the Government of Punjab Act No. 18 dated 20th July, 1998 and notified in the Punjab Government Gazette extraordinary dated 22nd July, 1998. The name of the said university has been included in the list of recognised universities maintained by the University Grants Commission under Section-2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956.

However, the above university, has not been declared fit to receive Central assistance in terms of the Rules framed under Section 12-(B) of the U.G.C. Act, 1956.
