General Terms and Conditions regarding the Posts

1. These posts are strictly temporary and the job period will not exceed more than three years as the project duration is three years only. If the project gets terminated before completion due to any reason, the posts will also be terminated.
2. The initial appointment would be given for Three months, following which there will be performance evaluation of the candidates. Further extension would be given on Quarterly basis till maximum of total 48 months duration or the completion of project. The same rules would be followed before giving extension as in First time.
3. The services of the selected candidates may be terminated by the employer after giving one month notice. The selected candidates can also leave the job after giving one month notice.
