### **General terms and conditions:**

1. **Application fee:**- The applicant must enclose demand draft (Non-refundable) in favour of The Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot payable at Faridkot as under:

General Category- Rs.2360/- (Fee Rs.2000 + GST Rs.360 @ 18 %) SC Category- Rs.1180/- (Fee Rs.1000 + GST Rs.180 @ 18 %)

- 2. The University has right to increase or decrease the number of posts at any stage without citing any reason or not to fill any or all the posts.
- 3. **Upper Age limit**: calculated as on 1<sup>st</sup> January of 2025.

**Medical Faculty:** The candidate should not be more than forty (40) years of age in the case of Assistant Professor, forty five (45) years of age in the case of Associate Professor and fifty (50) years of age in the case of Professor. Relaxation is upper age limit as per Punjab Govt. Rules.

**Senior Resident** The candidate should not be more than 45 years of age in the case of Senior Resident (As per NMC Notification dated 14.02.2022).

**Junior Resident:** The candidate should not be more than 37 years of age in the case of Junior Resident, relaxation in upper age limit as per Punjab Govt.
