The Key Focus Areas of The Phytomedicine Department:

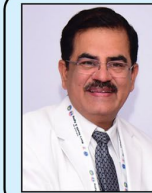

Eminent Speakers



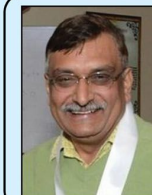

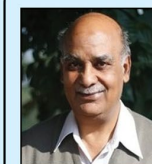

- For each theme in poster presentation, 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize will be awarded to the students / researchers.

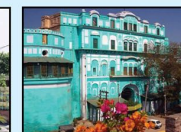
